Next Bibeleskäse (a light version of cream cheese) is smeared across the surface. The dish is finished with your topping of choice including: meat, fish, vegetarian or vegan products.

Uitleg termen

Session

The Session style comes from the craft beer world (special beers from small breweries) and is an umbrella term for craft beer that is brewed to a lower alcohol percentage. Dutch brewers are starting to brew more and more beers of this style in the last year, which is already common in America. The Session style challenges the better brewer to brew a beer that has the distinctly full flavor that craft beers are known for, but with less alcohol. That works fine.

Sour

Sour beers are traditionally made by deliberately allowing wild yeast strains or bacteria into the brew. Nowadays fruit is added that contributes to organic acids, so that the beer has a fresh sour taste. In the traditional process, the beer may take months to ferment and possibly years to mature. However, with modern methods, sour beer can be made within a few days.

Wheat & Weizen

Wheat beer and Weizen are different beers but are often mixed up. Both beers are cloudy because they are not filtered and both contain barley malt and wheat malt, which gives the beer a fresh and soft taste. They are both pale yellow to blond in colour. Weizen, originally from Germany, contains only grain, water and hops. Nothing is added, that's why the Weizen tastes fresh, sweet, sour and full of flavour. Wheat beer, originally from Belgium, also contains other ingredients. The addition of coriander seeds and orange peel gives the wheat beer a sweet-sour and spicy taste.

IPA

IPA stands for Indian Pale Ale. More hops are added to this, from origin, English beer than to lager. That creates more bitterness. You also taste many fruity flavors, which differentiate the bitter tastes again. The alcohol percentage is between 5% and 7.5%. But the amount of alcohol in an Imperial IPA is often higher.

Porter

Porter is a dark style of beer developed in London from well hopped beers made from brown malt. The name was first recorded in the 18th century and is thought to come from its popularity with street and river porters.


Stout

Stout is a beer type best known by the dark brown almost black colour and the burning bitter sweet that comes from the use of roasted malt. There are bottom-fermented and top-fermented variations. Stout is a variant of the Porter beer, which has the same characteristics to a lesser extent.

Zundert 8 8.0%

The first beer of the Trappists from Zundert. It is a chestnut-coloured that undergoes a secondary fermentation in the bottle. It contains 8% alcohol. The beer can be described as slightly unruly. This means that Zundert Trappist is beer that you have to take time to understand. The beer has a highly promising aroma with a hint of herbs and spices. Initially Zundert Trappist was floral and slightly sweet. Give the beer some time and the character develops from light caramel to a lovely, dry and hoppy bitterness. In the long finish the bitterness melds with a pleasant spiciness in the background.

With this beer we won the title of Hero of the Taste of Brabant in 2002 (a beer competition). Brewed with various dark malts, hop from the village of Schijndel and spelt from the village of Liempde, this beer is as black as the darkest night.

Sherpa Porter 6.0%

This worker beer, originally from Dublin, was often consumed by porters. It's related to the Stout and is very dark in colour. It is a 100% barley beer with a bitter aftertaste due to the considerable amount of added hops. Nevertheless, it has become a wonderfully soft beer due to its chocolate and coffee notes.

La Trappe Oak Aged 11.0%

In order to restore an old tradition, Bierbrouwerij de Koningshoeven started in 2009 with the ripening of La Trappe Quadrupel in oak barrels. This creates a unique Trappist beer with a balanced flavour, special wood flavour and an alcohol percentage of 11%.

ReuZ Koffieporter Barrel Aged Whisky 10.5%

This variety of the original ReuZ Coffee Porter is complex, full of taste and creamy because of the addition of rye. The coffee aroma and taste are produced by coffee malt and fresh Arabic coffee beans. All this has matured in whiskey barrels for a year. The strong aromas of the whiskey alcohol and that of the wood are clearly present and make the porter even more interesting than he already was.

You can easily recognize the wine in the aftertaste, so the triple ends with a fine slightly acidic finish.

Originating from a beer called “birrebeer”, this is the honey among Spelt beers. This is a top fermented amber coloured beer with Schijndel honey and hops, brewed according to traditional methods; of course with spelt from Liempde.
