The secret? A wafer-thin base of flour, water and a pinch of salt. On top comes a fresh layer of crème fraîche (the original bibbelliskäse), after which we top it with surprising toppings: from savory meat and fresh fish to colorful vegetarian varieties.

The freshness of the Flammkuchen and the rich flavors of our Brabant beers enhance each other in a unique way. A combination that will make you happy!

Explanation of Terms

Session

A Session beer is the solution for those who like to drink several glasses without ending up under the table immediately. This style, originating from the craft beer world, usually has around 4% alcohol. The challenge for the brewer? To make a beer that is just as full and flavorful as a strong specialty beer, but lighter in alcohol. Already hugely popular in America for years, and now increasingly found in the Netherlands as well.

Wheat & Weizen

Two beers that are often confused with each other, but are truly different.

- Weizen (Germany): brewed with only grain, water, and hops. Fresh, soft, slightly sweet and sour, and full of flavor.
- Witbier (Belgium): gets an extra twist by adding coriander seeds and orange peel. This makes it fresher, spicier, and with a subtle citrus edge.
What they have in common: cloudy, blonde to pale yellow, and wonderfully refreshing.

IPA

The India Pale Ale (IPA) is the rock star of the beer world: hoppy, pronounced, and often with a strong bitterness. Originally invented in the 18th century to survive the long boat trip to India – hops and alcohol acted as natural preservatives. Today it is known for fruity and floral aromas, ranging from gently hoppy to explosively bitter. An absolute favorite in the craft beer scene.

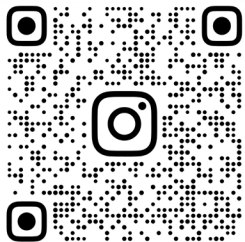
Stout

Dark, powerful, and full of character. A Stout is immediately recognizable by its deep roasted flavors: think coffee, dark chocolate, caramel, and sometimes even a hint of licorice. Creamy, full-bodied, and perfect for those who love intense beers.

Barrel Aged

Patience is rewarded with a Barrel Aged beer. This beer matures for months (sometimes years) in wooden barrels. As a result, it gains a rich, layered flavor with notes of wood, vanilla, caramel, and sometimes a hint of smoke or fruit. Often strong in alcohol and always impressive in complexity. A beer to enjoy slowly.

Bavaria 0.0%

A refreshing 0.0% beer that tastes like pilsner. This is achieved by using a new brewing method, removing the alcohol from the beer at a very low temperature.

La Trappe Witte Trappist 5.5%

Witte Simmie 5.2%

When pouring Witte Simmie, you are greeted with a seductive aroma of orange peel and lemongrass, thanks to the Cascade hops. The scent is fresh and lively, inviting a refreshing sip. The beer has a soft and fresh taste, with wheat forming the base for a light malty sweetness, nicely balanced with subtle spicy notes and the refreshing citrusy hop aromas.

Miss Paddle Weizen 5.4%

BRONZE Dunkelweizen 6.5%



Bronze is a wheat beer with, among other things, wheat malt. The malt is partially caramelized, giving this specialty beer its specific aroma and flavor. A classic yeast and a German hop provide a spicy aroma and a touch of bitterness in the finish, which balances the sweet tones of the malt.

La Trappe Isid'or 7.5%

Amber-colored Trappist beer with an off-white foam head. The harmonious flavor starts fruity and transitions into malty caramel. Named after Brother Isidorus: the first brewer of the abbey in 1884.

Blonde



La Trappe Blond 6.5%

Golden-yellow Trappist beer with a white foam head and a rich taste experience. An accessible, sparkling beer with a lightly sweet, gently bitter, and malty flavor.

Sorghum zwaar blond (Gluten Free) 7.5%

Blonde beer with local ingredients and Belgian yeast, spicy, fruity, and easy to drink.

La Trappe Dubbel 7.0%

Classic dark brown Trappist beer with an ivory foam head. Full malty and caramel-sweet flavor with a subtle, sweet influence of dates, honey, and dried fruit.

Speltbier Dubbel 7.5%

This spelt beer dubbel was born from the brewery's first beer, namely the "vattumus." Nowadays it contains a bit of spelt, which gives this dark beer an extra character; flavorful with caramel and a pleasant sweetness.

Quad Fundum 10.0%

Soft, sweet, spicy, and fruity quadrupel that also has dark flavors of coffee, cocoa & warming alcohol. A rich, complex, yet smooth quadrupel that you certainly shouldn't drink in one go.

La Trappe Quadrupel 10.0%

Characterful Trappist beer and the namesake of this beer style. Warm amber-colored with a cream-colored foam head. The full, warming, and intense flavor is malty with sweet notes of dates and caramel.

Tripel



Strijder Roggetripel 8.0%

This robust tripel is slightly cloudy due to the use of rye malt. Together with English hops, this gives a spicy flavor, further enhanced by the English yeast. The finish is remarkably smooth.

Triplex 9.5%

Perfect harmony between bitterness, spiciness, sweetness, fruitiness, and alcohol. An extraordinarily elegant and complex beer, with layers to enjoy at your leisure.

La Trappe Tripel 8.0%

Golden blonde with a white foam head. A classic Trappist beer with a powerful, full flavor, fruity notes, and a candy-sweet and lightly malty character.

Andreas 8.5%

Andreas is an ode to the beautiful city of Breda and the people who make the city the vibrant place it is today. This tripel has hints of spices but remains accessible. It uses pilsner malt, wheat malt, and oat flakes. Andreas is known for its spicy and floral notes, which complement the natural sweetness you can expect from a classic Tripel.

Orchestra of Angels 6.3%

Our award-winning New England IPA. It combines its hazy appearance with an explosion of tropical fruit thanks to the use of truckloads of hops after boiling and double dry-hopping during maturation. 'Bitter' takes on a whole new meaning – liquid creamy gold, a double drink for adults! Discover for yourself how an orchestra can sound!

White IPA 6.0%

Winner of Brabants Lekkerste Bier 2021. An India Pale Ale with 50% wheat malt, a German hop, and an English yeast strain. Unlike the bitter IPAs, this beer has become wonderfully smooth with an emphasis on hop aroma without bitterness. This beer is the fifth wheat beer developed in our brewery.

Juice Punch 5.8%

Our flagship, Juice Punch, is a New England IPA that delivers a flavorful punch with a mix of Citra, Mosaic, and Sabro hops. At the first sip, you experience a juicy explosion of flavors, with a refreshing mouthfeel and notes of citrus, coconut, pineapple, and stone fruits.

Hopcreator IPA 6.7%

Speltbier Stout 6.0%

With this beer, we became Hero of the Taste of Brabant in 2002. Brewed with various dark malts, Schijndelse hops, and Liempd spelt, this beer is as black as the darkest night.

Scream & Stout 10.5%

Award-winner of Brabants Lekkerste Bier! Creamy notes of cocoa and coffee with a spicy hop bitterness and a licorice-like warming alcohol flavor. Very strong, very dark Imperial Stout with a heavily roasted and bold character.

Special Forces 8.0%

Under the sublabel "Special Forces," Brouwerij Strijder releases unique, numbered batches of special beer. Stronger and more pronounced in flavor, specifically intended for the true enthusiast. Often Barrel Aged, usually dark, and at least 8% ABV. Each Special Forces beer is brewed only once and is therefore only temporarily available.
